The CMRC is excited to announce the publication of a revised *Appendix to the Canadian Competencies for Midwives* that better meets the needs of marginalized people in midwifery care!

The Appendix is an important companion document to the *Canadian Competencies for Midwives (2020)*.

The Appendix expands upon the Primary Care Provider role to outline the entry-level skills & abilities expected of a Canadian midwife entering practice in the following areas:

- ▶ Assessment
- ▶ Decision-Making
- ▶ Care Planning
- ▶ Implementation
- ▶ Population Health
- ▶ Sexual and Reproductive Health

In 2023-2024, the CMRC Competencies Appendix was revised to support greater inclusion and equity for marginalized people including midwifery clients who are Indigenous, racialized, sex or gender-diverse, under-housed, im(migrants), and more.
